In the past few months, thousands of people took part in ACRI's "Writing on the Wall" campaign and hung thousands of posters across Israel. The posters included data on social rights in Israel, demonstrating how the policies of consecutive governments

have widened social gaps and eroded the people's right to a dignified life Independently and at the same time, the "tent protest" spread throughout Israel – amplifying our message with its demand for social justice.

The conclusion is now clear:

Without social rights and without equality there can be no democracy.
